# **Airman Knowledge Testing Changes**

- The latest version of the FAA Airman Knowledge Testing Applicant Identification, Information Verification, and Authorization Matrix is posted <u>here</u>.
- To locate a commercial or military Airman Knowledge Testing Center, you may navigate to the PSI True Talent website, located <u>here</u>.
- Every airman applicant, who does not already have an FAA Tracking Number (FTN), should register for one, via the Integrated Airman Certification and/or Rating Application (<u>IACRA</u>) Website, prior to taking an airman knowledge test. For additional information, click <u>here</u>.
  - An IACRA enhancement is under development to allow recording of Airman Certification Standards (ACS) Tasks and Elements in a Notice of Disapproval. The enhancement is expected to be released before the end of this year.
- Effective January 13, 2020, several changes were implemented to the Airman Knowledge Test Report (AKTR) process. For additional information, click <u>here</u>.
  - An Applicant ID will no longer be printed on the AKTR. The FTN will be printed in place of the Applicant ID.
  - ACS Codes will be printed on the AKTR for ACS-based exams. Currently, the following exams are based on published ACS documents: ACM, ASC, ATM, ATS, CAX, CCP, ICP, IFP, IRA, MCN, PAR, PCP, UAG, and UGR.
  - An embossment (raised seal) is no longer required on the AKTR.
  - For exams taken on or after January 13, 2020, an applicant may print a duplicate AKTR via the <u>PSI True Talent Website</u>.

*Note:* <u>FAA Notice 8900.536</u>, Changes to the Airman Knowledge Test Report (AKTR), was issued on January 27, 2020.

#### **Reference Handbooks**

With the assistance of aviation community members of the Aviation Rulemaking Advisory Committee (ARAC) Airman Certification Standards (ACS) Working Group (WG), the FAA is reviewing and revising a number of its reference handbooks.

#### Handbook(s) scheduled for release in May 2020:

- FAA-H-8083-9B, Aviation Instructor Handbook
  - Chapters have been reorganized throughout.
  - "Student" has been replaced with "Learner" throughout.
  - References to "Airman Certification Standards" have been added, alongside "Practical Test Standards."
  - Scenario-based training, relative to assessments, has been expanded upon (see chapter 6).
  - "Cockpit" has been replaced with "Flight deck" throughout.
  - A new chapter has been added on "Teaching Practical Risk Management During Flight Instructions."
  - Appendix C has been updated to account for changes in the submission process for an Airman Certificate and/or Rating Application through IACRA.
  - Appendix C has been updated to account for Remote Pilots.

- Examples of endorsements have been removed from Appendix C. (Refer to AC 61-65, Certification: Pilots and Flight and Ground Instructors, for a listing of suggested endorsements.
- Appendix E, Relationships of Decision-Making Models has been removed.

#### General Information Applicable to Pilot Knowledge Test Banks:

• Questions about Hazardous Inflight Weather Advisory Service (HIWAS) have been removed from <u>all</u> airman knowledge test banks.

#### Fundamentals of Instructing Knowledge Test Bank:

 The May 29, 2020, Aviation Instructor Handbook (FAA-H-8083-9B) release will not affect the June 2020 new/revised test question activation. However, this handbook release will affect the September 2020, new/revised test question activation. At that time, questions will align with the most recent edition of the Aviation Instructor Handbook (FAA-H-8083-9B).

#### Aircraft Dispatcher Airman Knowledge Test Bank:

- Questions about runway distance remaining as determined by runway lighting as seen from the flight deck were removed effective March 30, 2020.
- Questions about Automatic Dependent Surveillance-Broadcast (ADS-B) Out were added effective March 30, 2020.

#### Private Pilot – Airplane and Helicopter Airman Knowledge Test Bank:

• Questions about Automatic Dependent Surveillance-Broadcast (ADS-B) Out were added effective March 30, 2020.

#### **Commercial Pilot – Airplane and Helicopter Airman Knowledge Test Bank:**

• Questions about Automatic Dependent Surveillance-Broadcast (ADS-B) Out were added effective March 30, 2020.

#### Instrument – Airplane Airman Knowledge Test Bank:

• Questions about Intentional GPS Interference will be added effective June 29, 2020.

#### Airline Transport Pilot (ATP) – Airplane Airman Knowledge Test Bank:

- Questions about Automatic Dependent Surveillance-Broadcast (ADS-B) Out were added effective March 30, 2020.
- Questions about Very High Frequency Omnirange Station (VOR) Operational Network (MON) were added effective March 30, 2020.
- Questions about terms used by pilots and Air Traffic Control (ATC) when furnishing quality of runway braking action reports were added effective March 30, 2020.
- Questions about Intentional GPS Interference will be added effective June 29, 2020.
- Questions about FICON NOTAMs will be added effective June 29, 2020.
- Questions about Runway Condition Reports and RwyCCs will be added effective June 29, 2020.

#### Airline Transport Pilot (ATP) – Helicopter Airman Knowledge Test Bank:

• Questions about Automatic Dependent Surveillance-Broadcast (ADS-B) Out were added effective March 30, 2020.

## Helicopter Commercial, Flight Instructor, and Airline Transport Pilot (ATP) Airman Knowledge Test Banks:

• Questions about vortex ring state, tail rotor effectiveness (LTE), and autorotation were revised effective March 20, 2020. This revision aligned questions with FAA-H-8083-21B, Helicopter Flying Handbook published October 2019.
